We know that there is very limited support in Newcastle for people with a head injury once they leave hospital and return home. However, we know that a head injury can have a long term impact. We are proposing some new research. In this research, we will (1) learn more about people's long term needs, and (2) work out how best to meet those needs. Needs might involve work, community, relationships and anything else that is important to you.

At the moment, we are at a very early stage of this research as we apply for funding. If we get funding, we would then start the research. We want people affected by head injury to have their say about every part of the project - including this very early stage. We want to know what your hopes and aims for the project would be. We will be at the Headway meeting on 18th April. Please come and have a chat with us.
